To date the following groups are scheduled to participate Bow Parks and Recreation, Bow, Dunbarton and Weare Police Departments, New England Canine Search and Rescue, Dunbarton Fire Department, Bow Fire and Highway Departments, American Red Cross, NH Fish and Game, NH Liquor Commission and Concord Community Acupuncture. There will also be tables and representatives providing information on a wide variety of community initiatives such as DARE, Concord Crime Line, E-911, Citizens Academy, Rape Aggression Defense (RAD) training and seat belt safety.

The Bow PTO will be cooking out and there will be ice cream available so plan on coming out for dinner, dessert and an evening of family fun.
