Dunbarton Police arrest suspect in July Burglary of Pages Country Store

After a lengthy and involved investigation the Dunbarton police have arrested a suspect in the July 26th burglary of Pages Country Store on Concord Stage Road. At approximately 5:04 AM on July 26th the Dunbarton Police responded to a report of a burglary at the store. The burglary was discovered when an employee entered the store to prepare for the days business.

Through their investigation and crime scene processing officers determined that the suspect had forced entry through a rear door of the store. Once inside the store the suspect pried the ATM machine and cash register drawers open. The suspect made off with a considerable amount of tobacco products including cases of cigarettes and chewing tobacco. A large amount of cash was also reported stolen during the burglary. In addition to the items stolen there was extensive damage caused to the ATM, cash registers and interior of the building.

Reynolds was charged with burglary. Reynolds will be arraigned on the felony charge at the Concord District Court on September 1 at 10:00AM. Reynolds is currently being held at the NH State Prison in Concord.
