At the 10/12/2017 BOS meeting, the Board reviewed the tax rate as set by the Department of Revenue. The remaining fund balance for Dunbarton per Auditor's MS535 Financial Report is \$268,634, considering the unassigned fund balance per GAP requirements. The recommended fund balance per DRA is 5% or a minimum retention of (\$449,721). The current amount retained including <u>all</u> fund balance to set the tax rate is \$460,413. The Board reached a consensus not to use any fund balance to reduce the Municipal portion of the tax rate.

The overall increase over 2016 taxes is \$1.63.
